

Admissions Statement 2023-24

1 Introduction

- 1.1** The Heart of Mercia Multi Academy Trust is the admissions authority for its academies, although the responsibility for admissions is delegated to the Local Governing Bodies of each academy of the Trust.

2 Aims & Objectives

- 2.1** The Local Governing Body of each academy of the Trust will ensure that appropriate procedures for admissions are adhered to on behalf of the Trust and will review and approve admissions arrangements prior to the start of each academic year.

3 Admissions

All academies of the Heart of Mercia Multi-Academy Trust have admissions policies that can be found on their websites.

Admissions and appeals to our schools are administered by the relevant Local Authority.

Issues concerning oversubscription to one of our schools are dealt with using that school's Admissions policy.

Admissions and appeals to one of our Sixth Form Colleges are administered by that college using their Admissions policy and criteria.

5 Admissions of Children outside of their normal age group

5.1 Parents may seek a place for their child outside of their normal age group if the child may have experienced significant problems or missed a substantial part of a year for reasons of ill-health.

Admissions authorities of each Academy will make decisions on a case-by-case basis using their Admissions policy and criteria, informing parents of their statutory right of appeal.

6 Appeals (Years 7-11)

6.1 Any young person refused a place at an academy within the Trust have a right of appeal to an independent appeals panel. Please refer to the relevant academy admissions policy for further details.

7 Appeals (Sixth Form)

7.1 Admission into an academy sixth form or one of our sixth form colleges is dependent on criteria such as students meeting the entry requirements of that academy; a satisfactory reference from previous school (where required by the local admissions policy); and space on the courses the young person is looking to study.

The allocation of a place is at the discretion of the academy Headteacher or Principal, but the criteria for admission will be clearly outlined in the academy admissions policy. The right of appeal will also be outlined in the relevant academy policy.
